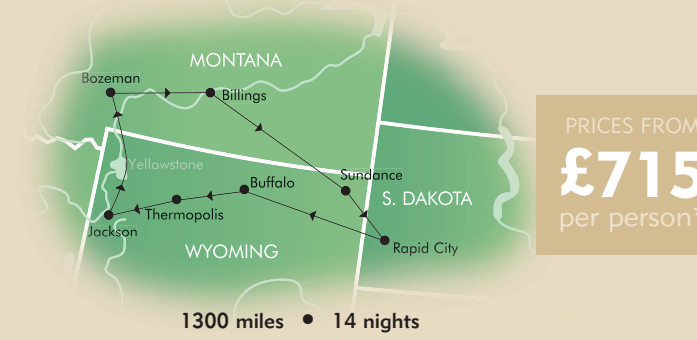
## the last best places

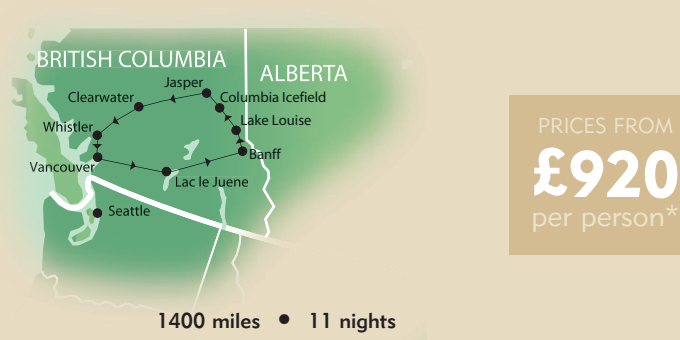
## lodges of western canada

This tour includes accommodation in some stunning lodges including Tyax Mountain Lake Resort in Goldbridge and Buffalo Mountain Lodge in Banff.

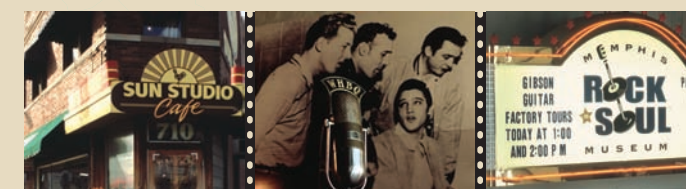
